The Hasiye Kevansaray is reached soon after Homs after passing several seventeenth-century examples. Here Süleyman I added a large second court to the existing humble han built round a court beside a fort. The new great hall has two rows of ten columns on the west with colonnades outside for summer rest. There is a square mesit with a two-column porch in the centre of the court and a rectangular pool to the east of it. Its similarities to Selçuk-style hans are immediately apparent.
